

Today, I'm going to write about "the mystery of the horse bridles."
Let's think about the meaning of the horse bridles, written in the book of Revelation.

Revelation 14:18-20

And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy the sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.

It says here that, the blood which came out from the great winepress of the wrath of God reached the horse bridles. "Horse bridles" is not a familiar word to us. It is quite common if it says the water from the river rose and went over the dike, but in this article, it says horse bridles. That is a unique expression. It has some hidden meaning or a "mystery of the kingdom of heaven." That's why I'd like to talk about it. Jesus talked about the mystery of the kingdom of heaven in the Bible.

Matthew 13:10-11

And the disciples came, and said unto him, why speakest thou unto them in parables?

He answered and said unto them, because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.

Jesus says the mystery of kingdom of God exists, and that is covered with parables and hidden from people. Therefore, we would like to comprehend the parables about horse bridles and its mystery. The word 'horse bridle' is mentioned in the book of James, see below.

James 3:1-3

My brethren, be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation.

*For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to **bridle** the whole body.*

Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body.

According to the passage, the word 'horse bridle' is used, relating to masters and condemnation to them. Therefore, the horse bridle probably implies the masters. The whole body of the horse signifies the church and horse bridle signifies the master who leads the church. Let's have a look at the James chapter 3 again.

1 My brethren, be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation.

It says the masters shall receive the greater condemnation. Therefore the subject of James chapter 3 is about masters, disasters caused by misleading masters and the condemnation masters receive.

2 For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body.

In this passage, offense in the word of masters is mentioned. 'Word' is written 'logos' in Greek, and this also means the word of the Bible. In short, the misunderstanding about the words of the Bible is what is referred to in this passage.

Therefore, it is clear that offense in the word of masters means the misunderstanding of the word of the Bible. This occurs when the masters do not understand the word of God correctly and, consequently, mislead an audience. For example, today's pastors do not understand the words of the End times totally, and they say such things like "Meeting with a disaster in the End are for Jews" and "Christians never meet the disaster and never receive condemnation in the End." These misinterpretations are one of the misunderstandings of the words of the Bible.

3 Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body.

In this passage, bits mean masters, and whole body means whole church. The big horse is controlled by small bridles, so also, the church is controlled by one master. For example, a Pope says "There is no hell," and misleads the whole catholic churches.

James 3:4-6

4 Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.

In this passage, very small helm means a master. A small helm steers a large ship, similarly, one master leads the church. For example, if the master admires Benny Hinn, the church will be deceived and affected by satan.

5 Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!

6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

In this passage, tongue implies a master, and whole body implies whole church. In addition, it tells about disaster for the church, which will be initiated by the master.

"...tongue...defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell"

This means following; By master, parabled as tongue, the whole church will be burned and fall into hell. Such terrifying things are written in this passage but it is a reality. A wrong master accepts the homosexuality forbidden by the Bible, and its church becomes like Sodom and makes whole church dirty. Christians who accept homosexuality will be condemned by God and put into hell.

Fire is also a metaphor of something spiritual. A master, who accepts satanic spirit of Pensacola revival and preaches it to an audience, will burn his whole church by satanic fire.

An audience goes to hell by master? This sounds like nothing but a joke, but it is written in the Bible, so let's think about it. This is mentioned by God himself, see below.

[Matthew 23:15](#)

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

In this passage, wrong scribes and Pharisees, that is, wrong masters, make an audience the child of hell. Of course, Child of hell goes to hell after its death. This is terrifying fact but God told us so. It is clear how catastrophic wrong masters can be.

[James3:9-12](#)

Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God.

Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be. Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter?

Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? either a vine, figs? so can no fountain both yield salt water and fresh.

Blessing or cursing comes down to one master. This is true and a master will be blessed or will be cursed and have bitter water.

In other words, the Holy Spirit or evil spirit comes down to one master. This is true. Sometime blessing comes down, sometime cursing does to one same master.

That's why God said "Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter?" and it shouldn't be done.

A Master should always try to be blessed by the Holy Spirit, and be careful not to be cursed by an evil spirit or have bitter water.

14 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.

15 This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

According to the passage above, a master lying against the truth is mentioned, plus, the danger of preaching the wisdom of an evil spirit, not that from God.

A Master must not do like that, however, there are many masters who lie against the truth and preach the wisdom of evil spirits. For example, pre-tribulation rapture theology popularized by J.N. Darby in 19th century is exactly the wisdom of evil spirits. Many churches and Christians accept that theology so they don't make any preparation for tribulation.

Also, the prayer of Jabez encourages the principle of witchcraft. It encourages prayer to God using same words again and again. Such evil spirit is used by many churches. Let's go back to the book Revelation quoted at the beginning.

Revelation 14:18-20

18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast *it* into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand *and* six hundred furlongs.

The Vine signifies Jesus Christ, and also the relationship between the church and Christians.

John 15:1

I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

And then, God gathered the vine and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. It implies the condemnation of apostates and unrighteous Christians. So, at the Last day, they will be strictly punished.

14:20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand *and* six hundred furlongs.

In this passage, you can see the word 'horse bridles.' As mentioned above, it definitely implies master.

This is the summary; at the Last day, the condemnation, judgment or wrath of God is meted out to the horse bridles, in other words, MASTER. It is told as parables in the Bible. "The blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles" is pointing to the condemnation and punishment on masters.

I declare that the punishment will be greater than that which came upon Gehenna, so allow me to say this to dedicators; it is wonderful if dedication affecting God's actions and words rest upon us. However, we should be careful of words we say and we should fear the Lord, when we dedicate.

Don't make reckless remarks such as, "Christians don't go to hell," or "Pastors never do."

It is very possible for masters in this era to go to hell, as Jesus told the scribes and Pharisees.

Therefore, fear the Lord and follow his words. It is nonsense to say pre-tribulation rapture or anything like that.
